

1. Purpose and Scope

Nanometrics Incorporated (Nanometrics) values your privacy. We have worked hard to build trust with our consumers and will continue to do so. This privacy policy explains how Nanometrics will use any information collected from you when you visit our website. This privacy statement applies only to information collected by this website (Nanometrics.com).

Nanometrics collects information from you on its website in two ways: 1) personal information provided by you on the website, and 2) through the use of computer cookies.

2. Definitions

‘Personal data’ means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person (‘data subject’); an identifiable natural person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that natural person.

3. Information You Provide Nanometrics and Legal Basis for Processing

- **Product Information Inquiry:** The Nanometrics website provides the ability for you to submit a Product Information Inquiry. In order to submit a request, you enter Name, Company, Title, Address, Phone Number and Email Address. The Legal Basis on which Nanometrics processes this information is Legitimate Interest.
- **Product Upgrade Inquiry:** The Nanometrics website provides the ability for you to submit a Product Upgrade Inquiry. In order to submit a request, you enter Name, Company, Title, Address, Phone Number and Email Address. The Legal Basis on which Nanometrics processes this information is Legitimate Interest.
- **Customer Support Inquiry:** The Nanometrics website provides the ability for you to submit a Customer Support Inquiry. In order to submit a request, you enter Name, Company, Title, Address, Phone Number and Email Address. The Legal Basis on which Nanometrics processes this information is Legitimate Interest.
- **Investor Relations Contact Us:** The Nanometrics website provides the ability for you to submit an Investor Relations Contact Us request. In order to submit a request, you enter Name and Email Address. The Legal Basis on which Nanometrics processes this information is Legitimate Interest. The information collected on the Investor Relations Contact Us form is sent to the Headgate Partners LLC, the Nanometrics Investor Relations Vendor.

4. Cookies

Cookies are small text files that are stored locally on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work, or work more efficiently, as well as to provide information to the owners of the site. We will only store these cookies on your computer when you have provided us with your consent by clicking on the appropriate button(s) during your visit of our website. Data collected via cookies will be retained until consent is withdrawn.

Cookies may be set when accessing the Nanometrics’ website. Nanometrics must track the consent of Cookies and therefore will need to collect your IP Address. Since consent is tracked via your IP Address, if you visit the Nanometrics website from a different IP Address, you will be prompted again for consent to the use of Cookies.

5. Personal Data Retention

We will retain your personal data only for as long as is necessary. We maintain specific records management and retention policies and procedures, so that personal data are deleted after a reasonable time according to the following retention criteria:

- We retain the data as long as we have an ongoing relationship with you (in particular, if you have an account with us).
- We will only keep the data while your account is active or for as long as needed to provide services to you.
- We retain the data for as long as needed in order to comply with our global legal and contractual obligations.
- When consent is the legal basis, we retain the data collected via Cookies until consent is withdrawn.

6. EU Resident Data Subject Rights

When using our website and submitting personal data to us, you may have certain rights under the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). If you submit Personal Data to us (as that term is defined in the GDPR) from European Union, you have the following rights:

The right of access

You have the right to get confirmation that your personal data is being processed and the ability to access your personal data.

The right to rectification

You have the right to have your personal data corrected if it is inaccurate or incomplete.

The right to erasure (right to be forgotten)

If the data is processed on the basis of consent or legitimate interest, you have the right to request the removal or deletion of your personal data if there is no compelling reason for us to continue processing it.

The right to restrict processing

If the data is processed on the basis of consent or contract, you have a right to ‘block’ or restrict the processing of your personal data. When your personal data is restricted, we are permitted to store your data, but not to process it further.

The right to data portability

If the data is processed on the basis of consent or contract, you have the right to request and get your personal data that you provided to us and use it for your own purposes. We will do our best to provide your data to you within 30 days of your request.

The right to object

You have the right to object to us processing your personal data for the following reasons:

- Processing was based on legitimate interests or the performance of a task in the public interest/exercise of official authority (including profiling);
- Direct marketing (including profiling);
- Processing for purposes of scientific/historical research and statistics; and
- Rights in relation to automated decision-making and profiling.

Automated individual decision-making and profiling

If the data is processed on the basis of legitimate interest, public interest, or vital interest, you will have the right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling, which produces legal effects concerning you or similarly significantly affects you.

Filing a complaint with authorities

You have the right to file a complaint with supervisory authorities if your information has not been processed in compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation. If the supervisory authorities fail to address your complaint properly, you may have the right to a judicial remedy.
